### **JOYCE HENDERSON PAEDIATRIC OPHTHALMOLOGY FELLOWSHIP**

The legacy of a great Western Australian philanthropist is being preserved with the creation of a Fellowship for the prevention of eye injury in children. Joyce Henderson was strongly committed to supporting research into the health of children's eyes. That commitment has now been translated into the creation of a prestigious Fellowship, to be split between the Lions Eye Institute and Princess Margaret Hospital (Perth).

The Joyce Henderson Paediatric Ophthalmology Fellowship will fund a final year ophthalmology trainee or Fellow who wishes to specialise in paediatric ophthalmology.

The position will increase the research collaboration between Lions Eye Institute and Princess Margaret Hospital with 50% of time spent at the Lions Eye Institute. The Fellow's clinical responsibilities would mainly involve research and clinical service into prevention and treatment of children's eye injury in Western Australia and this component will be based at Princess Margaret Hospital.
