

Parking and public transport – Nedlands

The Lions Eye Institute is situated on the Queen Elizabeth II Medical Centre (QEIIIMC) site and parking may be limited at times. If you plan to drive to the Institute for your appointment please allow extra time to find parking.

Parking

There are various public car parks at the QEIIIMC, and these are indicated on the map. The closest car park to the Lions Eye Institute is at the Cancer Centre building on Gairdner Drive. Please remember to pay for parking at the automated pay stations.

ACROD parking

A number of ACROD parking bays are shown on the site map overleaf. Visitor parking fees apply.

Drop off bays

Several 15 minute drop off and pickup bays are located outside the Institute. These bays are electronically monitored.

Buggy service

QEIIIMC Trust operates a free buggy service to assist patients and visitors. For pick-up, phone the buggy operator between 9am and 4pm weekdays on **0481 438 731**.

Bus and train services

There are extensive bus services connecting QEIIIMC with the city, train lines and surrounding suburbs. A number of bus stops are located outside the main entrances to Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital at E and G block on Hospital Avenue.
